Reserved Grooming

- Cairn Terrier pre-reservations MUST be received by June 23, 2021! If received after this date, they will be returned.
 Reservations can then be made through Greeley KC using the form in their premium list. All pre-reservations are at a first received basis. We will keep a waiting list.
- Reserved grooming space is available in the Air-Conditioned Exhibition Building at 7:00 am, Wednesday. Spaces are approximately 8 x 8 feet. Some spaces may be irregular due to wall pillars. PLEASE SHARE, as we are limited to 50 spaces for pre-reservation available to the CTCA/CTCD. Of important note, the number of spaces may be reduced due to current State, County and/or City COVID-19 restrictions. Refunds will be issued as appropriate.
- Electrical outlets available but must be shared; no space has exclusive use of any outlet.
- Children must not run in the grooming area.
- A dog washing area is available outside the west end of the Exhibition Building, another one is located west of the Livestock Building.
- All buildings will be locked by 10:00 pm nightly & will re-open at 6:00 am Friday-Monday.
- Reservations are \$35.00 per space for six days. No partial day reservations will be accepted.
- Reserved spaces will be held for all six days. Setups are available as of 7:00 am on Wednesday. Early arrivals will have to wait until 7:00 am Wednesday to set up.
- Reservations are limited to 2 spaces per form, 2 forms per envelope for a total of 4 spaces per envelope. No more than 2 spaces per person.
- Reservations will only be confirmed if a legible email address is provided.
- NO EXERCISE PENS, PUPPY PENS OR COCKER PENS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE EXHIBITION BUILDING.
- Grooming spaces will be monitored & must be cleaned each day. Failure to follow instructions made by a show committee member can result in forfeiture of a reserved space.
- Free grooming is available in the Livestock Building, north of the 4-H Building.
- No Fax, Email, Walk-ins or Telephone Reservations can be accepted.
- No dogs in grooming areas after 10:00 pm on any day.

Greeley Kennel Club, Inc. August 16 - 23, 2021 Island Grove Regional Park - Greeley, Colorado

RV requests received after June 23, 2021 will not be parked with Cairn Terrier group; after June 23rd, mail directly to Greeley Kennel Club.

Vehicles in the park before Wednesday 8-18-21, if not in their assigned parking spot or power ped will be moved on Wednesday, August 18, 2021. RV parking will be at the direction of the GKC Parking staff, the Show Committee or its Designees.

Overnight parking will be available beginning at Noon on Monday, August 16, 2021. Anyone parking prior to or after August 23, 2021 will need to pay an additional fee to the City of Greeley per day (check-in at Island Grove Regional Park Outrider Building, "D" Street (Monday thru Thursday). You will be asked to move if not in your reserved spot on August 16, 2021, with the exception of National Specialties who have made arrangements with the GKC for extended RV parking. RV Request Close on Greeley Kennel Club closing date at the GKC PO Box, Greeley, CO 80632

- No overnight parking in the park without a paid fee and RV overnight parking is a privilege not a right.
- No parking refunds request after GKC closing date. Request may be made by mail or email before that date.
- All set- up must be in you assigned 50' x 20' site or space marking. No double-parking outside of a site for Fire Safety.
- Request for 50 Amp power at sites are based on availability at the date we receive your request. If we are out of 50 Amp sites you will be place in a 30 Amp RV site.
- Any vehicle with a pop-out must have cones (**provided by owner**) placed beneath the pop-outs on that RV.
- Parking requests after closing will assigned to RV sites at the gate in Lots "B" and "F" with 30 amp plugs or other site if available.
- All units must be self-contained. Exhibitors will be responsible for clean-up of their areas before leaving RV site.
- No discharge of greywater or sanitary tanks is permitted at sites. An RV dump site is available on the park grounds north of the Stampede Arena.
- You are responsible for securing your RV site each day (Cones, tables, etc). If you
 choose to pull-in and out of that RV site.
- Requests for specific RV sites are based on availability at the time requests are received.
- RV rigs coming to these shows with friends can move around within their assigned RV spaces only. You must notify parking staff at the check-in gate of your move for emergency contacts.
- RV longer than 50 feet will need two paid for two sites if needed. (Check with GKC RV parking by e-mail before closing)
- If you give an email address that is legible you will be notified with RV or Box Van site assignment within 10 days
- No double-parking at RV sites for Fire Safety as directed by Greeley Fire Marshal.
 Loading & Unloading is acceptable.
